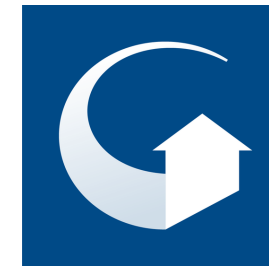

## MISSION: FILL THE BACKPACK

Every Summer, REALTORS® make it their mission to collect donations of backpacks, pencils, paper, crayons, notebooks, binders, and other school and craft supplies.
