- Must be 21 years of age and have obtained a high school diploma or its equivalent
- Must have at least three years experience as a licensed real estate salesperson
- Complete 16 credits or 240 hours of instruction within 10 years prior to date of passing licensing exam
- Satisfy at least 200 points in experience. You can find the point system at www.ghar.info/broker-licensure/ Note: Points are only awarded for full-time employment wherein no other points can be earned.
- Have successfully passed both the Pennsylvania and National portions of the PSI Broker Real Estate Exam
- Have completed, signed and submitted the licensing application provided by the Pennsylvania Real Estate Commission along with the required fee.
