




















Place of Work vs Place of Residence








Economic Benchmarking






GDP Growth







Sector Growth




GDP Growth Compared to Leading Industries in HCR

- Lancaster, Lebanon & York Counties 10%






Where HCR Employees Live

- 📕 Adams, Berks, Franklin & Philadelphia Counties 6.1%



Sector Distribution of Businesses: White & Person of Color




Housing

Housing Vacancy Rate in 2020




Income Allocated to Housing






A 15-Minute Region
