CE Deadline and License Renewal - May 31, 2024

What is Continuing Education?

All Pennsylvania real estate licensees (salesperson, associate broker, broker) must renew their license every two years. The current renewal period began June 1, 2022, and ends May 31, 2024. The Pennsylvania Real Estate Commission requires all real estate licensees (including brokers and associate brokers) to complete 14 hours of education each renewal period.

- If you were licensed before 12/1/21 you must complete 14 total hours of Continuing Education to include: 3 hours of the required 14 hours of continuing education must be taken in a topic that covers the responsibilities of the broker and the responsibilities of their licensees in regard to property management, advertising, and general supervision which would include, but not be limited to, commissions and fees.
- If you were licensed on or after 12/1/21. The Pennsylvania Real Estate Commission has developed 14 required hours of mandatory continuing education for all licensees in their first renewal cycle. The mandatory classes we offer are titled "General Module", "Residential Module", and "Commercial Module."
- If you are newly licensed or reactivated after 12/1/23, you will NOT have to take continuing education for this renewal cycle.

GHRI SCHOOL POLICIES

NOTE: At the time a GHAR member registers for a class, he assumes payment responsibility for that class. GHAR members may pay tuition (class fees) at the door. BEFORE CLASS

- Registration is required and available on our online education calendar.
- GHRI will send class materials to students via e-mail prior to the class with a link to download them through Dropbox. Please review the documents before class.
- We recommend that all attendees download the Zoom app prior to class and have access to a webcam. Students are required to stay on camera throughout the duration of the class.
- Make sure you have proper WIFI capability. To improve your WIFI in your home, turn off or disconnect other devices using the internet like phones and TVs. You may also buy a WIFI extender (1). Test the speed of your internet to make sure you are getting what you are paying your internet provider for and call your provider if not (2).
- Attendance will be taken at the beginning of class. Students should be prepared to show a Photo I.D. or Driver's license.

AFTER CLASS

- All GHRI classes will begin promptly at the published start time.
- If any technical difficulties arise during the class or if the instructor is late to begin the class, students should stay on the call until the issues are worked out. If a student loses connection they can get back on through the link again.
- We ask that students keep their microphone muted unless your instructor or meeting host says otherwise.
- Students must join the class with video to ensure presence and attention.
- When entering the Zoom class, we ask that students please type their name, and "here" in the Chat Box.
- Students must display their full name as it appears on their Real Estate License. (If you right click the right side of your screen, you should be able to rename yourself.)
- A GHAR staff person will attend each virtual class to monitor attendance and the chat feature.
- For attendance and PA SREC auditing purposes, classes will be video recorded.
- Students can and should ask questions in real time through the chat feature.
- For exams (if applicable), after the instructor leaves, staff will stay on zoom while the exam is administered via camera to monitor. Students will e-mail the exam to staff when completed.
- All Real Estate School policies apply to virtual classes.

1) A Range Extender, WiFi Booster or WiFi Extender is a device that repeats the wireless signal from your router to expand its coverage. It functions as a bridge, capturing the WiFi from your router and rebroadcasting it to areas where the WiFi is weak or nonexistent, improving the performance of your home Wifi.
