Requirements

Set by the PA State Real Estate Commission, licensees must take **two** modules:

- ◆ **Commercial Module**

NOTE: At the time a GHAR member registers for a class, student assumes payment responsibility for that class. GHAR members may pay tuition (class fees) at the door. Non-members must pay at time of registration. Tuition must be paid in full prior to the start of a class. Tuition payments are refundable if 48 hour cancellation notice is given. If a student leaves after a class begins, no portion of tuition is refunded.
